**DECISION OF THE WESTLAND DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE ON AN  
UNCONTESTED APPLICATION**

**AUTHORITY:**

Pursuant to section 191(2) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and a Council resolution dated 28 November 2013, the functions, powers and duties of the Westland District Licensing Committee are delegated to the committee chairperson where no objection has been filed, and no matters of opposition have been raised by the Police, the Medical Officer of Health or an Inspector. There is no Local Alcohol Policy in place for the District.

**Summary of Evidence**

The complete file has been made available to me.

A report from the Inspector concludes that the applicant is suitable to continue to hold a manager's certificate.

The Police advise that there are no objections to the application.

**Evaluation of Evidence**

I have considered the application on the basis of the uncontested reports received. The matter can be dealt with on the papers.

The applicant is employed at the Craypot at Jackson Bay where she is a waitress and restaurant worker.

I note that the applicant does have an historical conviction relating to excess breath alcohol. The Inspector is of the view that the offence is of such historicity that it does not impact on the question as to the suitability of the applicant. I agree with his analysis. This was a matter that I considered very carefully at the time of the original application. My assessment as to the issues at that time remain unchanged.


I am satisfied as to those matters provided for in s.227 of the Act, I am satisfied that the applicant is suitable, she does not have any relevant and recent convictions recorded against her, she has experience within the industry and she holds a recognised qualification.

**Decision and Reasons**

The application is granted on the papers pursuant to s.202 (1) of the Act as Decision Number **125-2021** and I direct that renewed manager's certificate 56/CERT/054/2020 be issued to Lisa Jane Glubb pursuant to s.64 of the Act.

The renewal is on the existing terms and conditions for a period of three years from the date of expiry.
